Parent Information and First Class Meeting:

Please plan to attend the Parent Information and first class meeting on **Monday, January 9th, at 3:15pm, Sowers Middle School, Rm. 410.** Both parents and students are encouraged to attend the first day of class together to see the wonderful display and demonstrations of all the instruments. Mr. Covacevich will answer questions and provide information on selecting an instrument, rental companies, and possible discounts. **Your child does not have to select an instrument prior to this meeting.**

Registration and Payment:

Parents and children must pick up an enrollment packet on the front counter of their child's school. Complete and sign the Emergency/Enrollment form included in the packet as the child must bring it to the first class meeting for admission (you will need to make a photocopy). Then, mail to the HB Adult School the enrollment & payment forms or turn in the forms to Mr. Covacevich at the Parent Information & First Class Meeting. **Thereafter, enrollments must be mailed to HB Adult School.**
